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Five Freedoms

- **1. Freedom from Hunger and Thirst** by ready access to fresh water and a diet to maintain full health and vigor.
 - **2. Freedom from Discomfort** by providing an appropriate environment including shelter and a comfortable resting area.
 - 3. Freedom from Pain, Injury or Disease by prevention or rapid diagnosis and treatment.
- **4. Freedom to Express Normal Behavior** by providing sufficient space, proper facilities and company of the animal's own kind.
 - **5. Freedom from Fear and Distress** by ensuring conditions and treatment which avoid mental suffering.

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The Concept

The Pet Project Malaysia, presented by Sabrina Saw in association with The British International School of Kuala Lumpur, is a huge charity event to take place on 7th January, 2012 to raise awareness and funds for animal welfare in Malaysia. This event is fully supported by The Department of Veterinary Services, Ministry of Agriculture & Agro-based Industries and the beneficiaries of the event include the following NGO's: PAWS, SPCA Selangor, Malaysian Dogs Deserve Better, Kucing Terbiar & Anjing Jalanan, AnimalCare, Paws Mission, H.O.P.E., Save a Stray, Independent Pet Rescuers and Zoo Negara. This is a non-profit event. All proceeds will be collected and shared between the NGO's in an agreed tier-system (with the exception of Zoo Negara's own donations collected).

In hopes of bringing awareness to the cause of animal welfare, we have organized a 12-hour "Get Active" marathon of dance, fitness and sports-based master classes to go from 11am to 11pm on the day of the event, at The British International School of Kuala Lumpur. These master classes will feature the industries' best global presenters from Hong Kong, Australia, The United States of America, United Kingdom, South Africa, Singapore and Malaysia. By getting active, we aim to utilize the power of positivity, and raise awareness for the cause in a healthy and exciting way. The master classes are open to all levels and ages and will consist of an assortment of preferences including: Tottenham Hotspur Football Clinic, Yoga & Core Strength for Golfers, Les Mills Programs and Freestyle Dance and Fitness Programs such as Cardio Dance, djRAW, Video Dance, Hip Hop, Salsa, Jazz, Tribal, Hi-Lo, etc. More details on the classes and presenters are available at www.thepetprojectmalaysia.org.

We will also be featuring many of Malaysia's rising young stars in our highly anticipated performances between our master classes. How does dance/fitness/sports relate to animal welfare, you may ask? You will have to come to find out©.

The Pet Project Malaysia's main event will run alongside with many other activities for all ages – this event has something for everyone.

For our younger crowd, a sports inflatables carnival will take place on the top floor of the school (Futsal and Playground floor) where face painters, ball jugglers and clowns will be. Our NGO booths will also be set up on this floor so that our guests get the opportunity to meet these organizations to learn more about them [and also meet their animals]!

Football fans will have the opportunity to participate in various Futsal games as well as contribute to Asia's Largest Football Card Montage to take place on the campus Tennis Courts. During the day, Tottenham Hotspur football talks will also be held for enthusiasts to learn more about the game and the club's holistic approach to football.

Those more adventure-inclined can literally "Climb for a Life" by rock climbing at RM1/ climb in support of animal welfare too.

There will be plenty of opportunities to purchase items from the event F&B booths, merchandise booths and the silent auction (with limited edition items donated by Taylor Made Adidas, authentic sports memorabilia by Football Focus, hotel packages from DoubleTree by Hilton, golf packages from Citygolf Malaysia and many, many more exciting items up for bids).

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Those who would like to challenge themselves in the name of animal welfare are also encouraged to become "Ambassadors" for the event. When you purchase your All Access Passes, you will also have the option of downloading an Ambassador Form. Help raise additional funds for the cause by getting your own sponsors to donate a certain amount of money per each class you choose to participate in. The more classes and individual sponsors you get, the more you are able to contribute to the donation pool.

Ticket sales to the event will commence in November (online and at selected outlets) where participants will be able to register for the master classes [of the main event] they wish to attend and/or the other activities during the day. Tickets will be sold either as 1) Spectator Passes or 2) All Access Passes.

Spectator passes include entrance to everything but the main event of master classes and performances, and will be sold for RM15 with the option of re-entry throughout the day. All Access Passes entitle participants to take part in the master classes on top all other activities. Price details are as follows:

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The Event Details

Using the explosion of the urban dance and fitness scene we feel now is the right time to bring it all together to raise awareness for animal welfare, both domestic and wild. 'The Pet Project Malaysia will bring dance and fitness enthusiasts together in 45-minute classes (running from 11am all the way through to 11pm) incorporating various dance, yoga and aerobic exercises (please see draft of class timetable online). We will also be challenging the participants on their endurance to see how many of the classes they can complete in order to raise funding for the local and national NGO animal welfare groups (please see Ambassadors).

Performances by local talent (taken from school groups, athletic teams and some of Malaysia's most promising rising young stars) will be included between classes and both classes and performances will be themed towards animal welfare. Various other gambits will be running alongside the classes and performances to ensure more profits are raised for the cause. Participants and Spectators will be able to attend the event while also visiting the sponsored booths, F&B booths, merchandise & bake sale booths, NGO animal welfare booths, sports carnival, Asia's largest football card montage, rock-climbing/"Climb for a life" and silent auction, etc.

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How It All Works

Registration & Passes

Tickets to the event will be available online from 1.5 months to the event via Petfinder.my. Class registration/pass purchase will be available online as well as at the door on the day of the event. Ticket pricing listed below. Class registrations will be available online when our ticket sales launch so you can register for your classes ahead of time. However, please be reminded that we cannot guarantee you a place in the class if you show up late... please do come early to ensure yourself a good spot ©.

Ticket Prices

Spectator Pass: RM15/day

- Able to enjoy the day with the exception of participating in the classes.

Participant Pass: RM25/1 class, RM35/2 classes, RM45/3 classes, RM55/All-day Pass.

- Participants are able to attend classes as well as enjoy the day's other activities.

We highly recommend for all to buy an All-day Pass as this allows you to access all areas @.

Passes & Traffic Flow

Upon registration at the ticketing counter (desk at main entrance), spectators & participants will be given lanyards with their respective tags. Spectators will be guided to all the various activities available but will not be allowed into the main event of the global master classes and performances. Participants will be given their lanyards with a class grid on the back of their pass. Upon registration at the ticketing counter, they will either bring their printed copy of their online ticket (to be collected and traded for lanyard) or register and pay at the counter. Class option(s) will be stamped off in the respective box(es) and checked upon entry to the participants area by volunteers. (Please see example below).

Participants will be asked to re-enter after each class. This is to ensure that all participants get a fair chance to stand where they want during class as well as effectively ensure participants have paid for the classes they wish to attend. Volunteers will need to be situated at the entrance to the indoor hall to check the passes accordingly. Ushers will also need to be situated inside the hall to help guide participants out to the booths & F&B area after each class. Instructors on stage will also remind participants to ensure a smooth-flow of traffic. Classes will be available on a first-come-first-serve basis.

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What Else Is Happening During the Day

Ambassadors

Participants who would like to be Ambassadors may download the following forms from various websites and The Pet Project official website (including schools, Petfinder.my, etc). <u>Carnival</u> Sports inflatables, face painters, clowns, ball jugglers, mascots, balloon twisters and radio DJs will be situated in the carnival. This is ideal for our much younger kids. To be held on the campus Futsal court where children can also enjoy the school's playground and visit various NGO booths.

Food & Beverage

All food and beverage sold at the event will be halal and there will be ample vegetarian options. We encourage you to stay hydrated during the event and keep your energy levels up – proceeds from the F&B sold will also contribute to our donation pool.

<u>First Aid</u> First Aid/Medical Teams to be present – sponsored by Tropicana Medical Center (please note: in case of serious injury, TPPM2012 organizers and partners are not liable).

<u>In Case of Emergency</u> The British International School of Kuala Lumpur's Staff/Volunteers/Teachers will be briefed prior to the event to assist participants into the proper drills should any emergency situations occur.

<u>Merchandise/Bake Sale</u> Event memorabilia such as T-shirts and professional photographs will be sold at the event. Cost of printing and production of these items will be included in the sponsorship

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costs. All profits will go to the donation pool collected by Charity Malaysia. Bake sale items will be brought in by volunteers and all items MUST be Halal and vegetarian.

<u>NGO Booths</u> NGOs are encouraged to set up booths on the school campus futsal court/ playground and of course bring their animals so participants can adopt them. All are encouraged to bring pet food and/or blankets, etc to donate to the NGOs as well. NGOs are also encouraged to sell their own merchandise to generate more donations specifically for their organization. NGO booths kept away from the gymnasium to avoid distress of animals (loud music/crowds).

Resting Areas

We will be utilizing the whole school for the event. Should you need to take a short break and rest, you may refresh yourselves with some F&B at the cafeteria area and/or relax around the campus.

Rhythm Tap with Jojo Struvs

This is a two-hour first come first serve basis rhythm tap class by celebrity Jojo Struys! Great opportunity to learn how to use your body as percussion! You don't want to miss this!

Rock-climbing Wall

Climb for a life! RM1 per climb with The British International School of Kuala Lumpur's dedicated staff to add to the donation pool!

Rugby

Practice your rugby skills by getting your game face on with some of our country's best rugby players on the top floor!

Security

Please note the entire campus will be protected by security and bodyguards (CPP Sdn Bhd) to ensure your safety and the safety of your valuables.

<u>Secured Check-In Room</u> As participants will be occupied with classes, it is important for their belongings to be kept in a safe place. They are not recommended to keep too many valuables with them but ARE encouraged to bring with them their cash/cheque books/credit cards so they may bid on the Silent Auction items as well as spend at the various booths. This room will be safely guarded by security as well as trusted volunteers from the partners and organizers involved. A ticketing system will be implemented to ensure an orderly flow of baggage storage.

Self Defense Classes
